

Thank you for purchasing the FURREAL FRIENDS LUV CUBS toy, the bear cub that moves and sounds like a REAL cub!

Requires 3 x 1.5V "C" or R14 size batteries (not included). Alkaline batteries recommended. Phillips/cross head screwdriver (not included) needed to insert batteries.

LUV CUBS are the lovable, huggable bear cubs that belong right in your arms! They can reach out to give you a hug and love to play peek-a-boo! Watch their facial expressions and listen to them make adorable baby bear cub sounds! Pet the soft fur on their back as you hug them and "feed" them with their very own baby bear cub bottle when they're hunary.

Be sure to take good care of your LUV CUBS by following the instructions in this booklet!


To begin playing with your LUV CUBS you must first install batteries

TO INSTALL BATTERIES

Pull back the plush flap on the bottom of the LUV CUBS bear cub. Use a Phillips/cross head screwdriver to loosen screw in battery compartment cover (screw stays attached to cover) on the bottom. Insert 3 x 1.5V "C"/LR14 alkaline batteries. Replace cover and tighten screw.

NOTE:

Your LUV CUBS bear cub will automatically go to sleep when the batteries are inserted. You can wake your LUV CUBS up by changing the ON/OFF switch to "ON".



- 1. Be sure to insert the batteries correctly and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions;
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or alkaline. standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries:
- 3. Always remove weak or dead batteries from the product.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Please retain this information for future reference. Batteries should be replaced by an adult.




CAUTION:

- 1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert item correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.
- 2. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- 3. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- 4. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- 5. Do not short circuit the supply terminals.
- 6. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
- 7. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of battery. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.

GETTING STARTED

FURREAL FRIENDS LUV CUBS bear cubs consist of the following parts:



Your LUV CUBS make a variety of realistic cub sounds and really:

- · Yawn • Coo
- · Sniff • Burp
- · Snore · Hiccup
- · Snort
- · Sigh

HOW TO PLAY WITH YOUR LUV CUBS

To turn your LUV CUBS ON, pull back the plush flap over the battery door and switch the ON/OFF switch to ON. Then replace the flap.



Once your LUV CUBS bear cub is turned on, he will yawn, stretch and then wake up. He is now ready to play with you!



NOTE: Your LUV CUBS will go to sleep and shut down if he is not played with for 3-5 minutes. You can wake him up by petting his back, feeding him, or squeezing his left foot. Please remember to turn the ON/OFF switch to the OFF position when you are not playing with your LUV CUBS, in order to conserve battery life.

To start playing with your LUV CUBS, pet his back or press his left foot.

Your FURREAL FRIENDS LUV CUBS are just like real bear cubs in many ways. The following illustrations show how you can play with your LUV CUBS bear cub.

Your LUV CUBS comes with a bottle designed for feeding. When you hear your LUV CUBS begin to make sniffing noises, you know it's time for him to eat! Place the end of his bottle into his mouth and listen as he slurps it up! You can also feed him whenever you want by placing the bottle in his mouth. If you stop feeding him and he still wants more, he will cry out for more! But watch out if you pet his back after feeding him, he may have a surprise burp in store for you! If you don't play with your LUV CUBS bear cub after you feed him, he may get the hiccups!






Hugging

Your LUV CUBS loves to be hugged and loves to hug you! Simply press his left foot for five seconds and he will give you a hug! Sometimes he will ask you for a hug automatically by stretching out his arms to you. Be sure to hug him tight and press his back sensor so he will hug you back.

Petting your LUV CUBS relaxes him and Julls him back to sleep. You will hear your LUV CUBS vawn - that means he is getting sleepy. Simply press down on his back for 5 seconds to Jull him to sleep - but be alert -LUV CUBS snore!



Plavina Peek-A-Boo is your LUV CUBS favorite game! Wait for him to cover his eves with his arms and then aently squeeze his left foot within 5 seconds. Watch as he plays a cute and friendly game of "Peek-A-Boo" with you!



Tickling

Your LUV CUBS loves to be tickled! Touch his left foot and he will giggle for 5 seconds!



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

To clean your LUV CUBS fur, gently brush him with a cloth or soft brush to loosen any dirt. Then use a slightly damp cloth to remove stains.

- DO NOT PUT IN THE WASHING MACHINE
- DO NOT SUBMERGE IN WATER
- DO NOT GET WET EXCEPT A DAMP CLOTH ON THE FUR
- TO PREVENT STAINING THE FUR, WIPE DIRT OFF **IMMEDIATELY**
- IF THE LUV CUBS GETS WET, REMOVE THE BATTERIES AND DRY THE FUR
- ONCE COMPLETELY DRY, REPLACE THE BATTERIES
- DO NOT USE DETERGENT OR STAIN REMOVERS ON THE FUR



High temperature will destroy the unit. Do not leave unit in direct sunlight.

- Prevent spills of food and beverage on the unit.
- Do not throw or kick the product, and do not push sharp objects through the speaker openings.
